II. **Approval of agenda** – motion by EJ to approve agenda; seconded by Ashley; unanimously approved.

III. **Approval of January minutes** - motion by EJ to approve January minutes; seconded by Ashley; unanimously approved.

IV. **Special Presentation by: Shelly Bania, CARE of Southeastern Michigan**

Topic: Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD). See powerpoint presentations. Also visit SAMHSA's FASD website and click on Michigan for more information. 100,000 kids potentially living with FASD just in Oakland, Wayne, and Macomb Counties. 5-6 month wait list for children to get assessed and there are only 5 diagnostic centers in Michigan. DHS; MDCH; DOE are key collaborators. Haven't integrated DOC as much yet.

V. **Brief Round table Reports**

Ashley Bergeon – St. Joseph Task Force – still working on a mentoring program. Just started Prime for Life with a day treatment center and it's going well. Looking into doing a sticker shock program around May and will be approaching youth groups. Starting Project Alert at a middle school club group. Working on an underage drinking pledge.

Angie Gullekson – Oakland County Health Department. Continues doing a Life Skills program in Oakland County. Doing retailer education, and compiling compliance check information and MIP numbers. Last year's packet is on website.

Mark/Linda – CARE of SEM. Sit on 10-11 coalitions in county. CARE has T3 youth group (Teens Talking Truth). Part of the Macomb County Prevention Network. Visit the MECOSA website for more information (www.mecosa.net). Chippewa Valley Coalition is having a "Current Drug Trends" work shop. 10 permanent Rx drug disposal boxes have been set up in Macomb County. East Detroit Coalition is growing and are doing a Rx drug abuse town hall meeting. Another coalition is having a psa contest. Law Enforcement has been very supportive. Brand new Mt. Clemens coalition has started. City of Warren coalition is growing and has formed a partnership with the Elks Club.

Andrew – Royal Oak Community Coalition – large focus on underage drinking. One of two coalitions that received the STOP grant. Working to implement the Above the Influence campaign in Royal Oak. “Parents Who Host, Lose the Most”; “21 to Buy, Not Supply.”

EJ McAndrew – some coalition members were able to secure money for a retailer folder that will include signage in it and other employee information. Adding survey post card to letter from prosecutor. The MCRUD parent-pledge card is also sent out. SADD groups doing well. EJ spoke about the video project they have been working on. Taking part in Rx drug take back in April. Local health clinic has received a grant and want to partner with Woodlands Behavioral Health.

Sarah Derwin – Marquette. RX drug drop off boxes are going well. Working out kinks on how to get the collected drugs to the incineration site. We assisted writing a meth prevention grant. We will find out this week if we get it.

Pam Milhisler – Clare/Mt. Pleasant. 1016 Recovery Network. Just got Rx drug box opened in Mt. Pleasant. On March 25 they will be hosting a Substance Abuse Symposium.

Janine Kravetz – Bay County. March 9 Domestic Violence group is having a fundraising event and it will be a Parenting Awareness Month event.

Ben Jones – NCADD GDA - has a youth group that has a prevention show airing every Tuesday. Youth are encouraged to call in and ask questions. Also, helping to plan the Celebrate Recovery Rally which is being held September 7 at Belle Isle.

VI. **Committee Reports & Recommendations**

- a. **Development** - Bringing on new board members. Retreat planned for April. Will be working on developing a development plan. The Partner with PN dinner still being planned for September in Traverse City.
- b. **MCRUD Policy** – info will be sent out and will be discussed at March meeting.
- c. **Executive Committee (EC)**
March 26 meeting was moved by consensus to March 19 due to the Traffic Safety Summit. Katy Gonzales will be our speaker and giving an epidemiology update; April 23 – Pat Sorenson from Michigan League for Public Policy will be presenting on Michigan’s budget. Both March and April’s meetings will be held at Prevention Network’s office in Lansing. Steering Committee decided to keep May’s meeting on the fourth Tuesday, May 28. A speaker and location is still being determined.

VI. **Local/State/National Issues** – MCRUD coordinator gave updates on the BAC bills (HB4093 and HB4131) and mentioned SB216 (bill to implement ORR recommendations).

VII. **New Business**

- a. **MCBAP hours** – MCRUD will start offering 1 MCBAP hour for steering committee presentations as long as the topic meets the criteria. Currently this will only apply to in person attendees. MCRUD coordinator will continue to look into offering MCBAP hours for those that call in on the conference line.
- b. **Alcohol Awareness Month** – MCRUD will compile a list of AAM activities. Look for an email soon.
- c. **Updating coalition directory** – Look for an email about this too. It will be in the form of a zoomerang survey. It will ask coalitions to update their contact person. It will also ask about youth involvement and if any of the coalitions have been involved in implementing the Life of an Athlete program.
- d. **Life of an Athlete Resources** - Updates to MCRUD website will include LOA resources. You can also check out www.michiganloa.org. MichiganLOA.org is also a Prevention Network website/resource.

VIII. Old Business –

a. Making the Case for Underage Drinking Presentations. The executive committee has determined that MCRUD doesn't have the capacity to do these right now.

b. Parent Power Works program. Andrew Corey and MCRUD coordinator has offered to review the program and offer feedback. Linda Zott and EJ McAndrew agreed to see if one of their colleagues would be willing to review the program. MCRUD coordinator will email them the link to the Parent Power Works program.
