- **Using Public Health and Community Partnerships to Reduce Density of Alcohol Outlets**
This study reviews the research on density of alcohol outlets and public health and describes the power localities have to influence alcohol outlet density. Community coalitions and public health departments can use evidence-based strategies, such as reducing alcohol outlet density to create healthier and safer communities.
